

THE ARTIST CLUBS OF THE HALL COUNTY AREA EXHIBITION AND SALE

Each club member may enter three works of art to be considered for acceptance. All entries will be carefully chosen to ensure that each artist has at least one piece of artwork accepted. The number of works will be decided with the exhibit space in mind.

Artist submissions will be made through mail or email of completed information and images to your club contact person who will forward this information to the Stuhr Museum. All entries must be submitted by Monday, August 26th, 2019. No original artwork will be accepted during this stage.

Each club contact person will be notified of artwork acceptance during the week of August 26th. **No artwork will be exhibited until the Stuhr Museum receives the \$10 per artist exhibit fee from each club's contact person.**

Artists may offer their selected works for sale during the exhibition if they choose. Artists will set their own prices and the Stuhr Museum will manage all transactions. The purchaser is responsible for the cost of shipping and handling. The Stuhr Museum receives a 40% commission for all sales.

History

Two prominent art clubs have dominated the Hall County art scene for over 50 years. The Grand Island Sketch Club began in 1922 and the Art Club began meeting in the early 1960s. The two clubs collaborated on exhibits and when the Stuhr Building opened in 1967, they were one of the first exhibitions. For over fifty years these clubs have exhibited their work together, and now the two clubs and the Stuhr Museum are opening the opportunity for other area clubs to join in. If you are in an art club that provides membership or services in Hall County please contact the Stuhr Museum to see how your club can be involved. This brochure serves as the individual artist application. Please be sure to fill it out accurately and communicate with your club. Each artist must submit the following information for each piece of artwork entered: **Title, Medium, Size, Club Affiliation, Sale Price (Optional) and Artist Statement (Optional).**

Please feel free to use the form on this brochure (copy as needed) if it is helpful. If you need help finding your club's contact person, feel free to contact the museum curator.

Any year of artwork created is an acceptable entry but can only be shown once in the annual exhibit.

No photographs under 8"x10" will be accepted.

A \$10.00 fee will be collected for each participating artist. Not for every piece, just for participation. **Artwork will not be exhibited until this \$10 fee has been collected by the Stuhr Museum.** See your club contact person for more details.

All exhibited works must remain on exhibit throughout the entire display period and may not be exchanged by the artist or purchaser.

All work must be properly framed and/or have secure, professional display equipment.

Pedestals will be provided for three-dimensional works.

Reasonable care will be taken to ensure proper handling of entries. The Stuhr Museum is not responsible for loss or damage of any prints, disks, or original works submitted for exhibition.

The Stuhr Museum will have permission to use any image of accepted artwork on its website or for promotion and education of the exhibit unless prohibited in writing by the artist.
